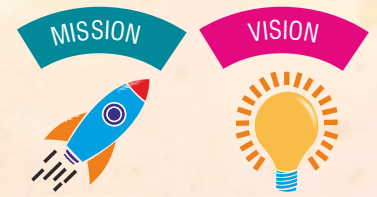
Aim & Objectives

Admission Process

1. Prospectus available from school, office from **2nd February** office timing will be **08:30 am to 04:30 pm**
2. First entrance exam to be conducted on **3rd Sunday of February**.
3. Results will be declared same day of Entrance Test.
4. Students who qualify written will appear for interview only after which the final list will be declared.
5. Once selected admission to be taken within a week failing which the seat if vacant will be allotted to the next candidate.
6. Date of Birth that will be the previous school's **Transfer Certificate** will be taken as final. Aadhar will not be the proof for Date of Birth.



Note : All vital information regarding the students like Parent's name, date of birth etc once submitted will not be changed at any cost.

Our Approach to Evaluation / Assessment

Weekly Assessments

20 min objective test that act as checkpoints in a student's academic schedule, conducted in the buffer periods to maintain a child's consistency.

Periodic Assessments

Objective and subjective tests conducted once in each term for all scholastic subjects, that accounts to 10% in final results.

Summative Assessments

Objective and Subjective tests conducted at the end of each term for all scholastic subjects except computers. These tests accounts for 40% in the final results.

Rules, Conduct & Discipline

- Students shall come to school on time and be neatly dressed in clean school uniforms. All the students are to wear the school tie and identity card at all times. (i.e. During school hours)
- No student shall leave the classroom without permission.
- Pupils changing classes must walk silently and in single line.
- Girl students shall not wear any Jewellery, have long nails or apply nail or apply nail polish/Kajal, mehendi when they come to school.
- Boy students must have a proper hair cut at all times. Long hairs, as well as long nails, are not permitted. No books, (other than text books or library books) magazines, comics, paper or music cassettes may be brought to school without the Principal's permission.
- In order to acquire a good command of the English language which is the medium of instruction for all subjects, children speak only in English in the school premises.
- No monetary collection for any purpose may be made in school without the previous permission of the Principal.
- Care must be taken of all school property and no students shall scratch on or spoil the desks or chairs or damage any school furniture, write or draw anything on the walls or in any way damage things belonging to others.
- Damage done even by accident, shall be reported at once to the school authorities. Any damage done even by accident shall be reported at once to the school authorities. Any damage done will be made good by the student responsible for it.
- Running and shouting in the school building is not allowed. When using staircases and corridors all must keep to the left.
- Walking or standing around the office area or the visitors, lobby shall be avoided even during recess. Students are not permitted to buy eatables from vendors outside the school grounds.
- Students are not allowed to leave the school premises. Without the permission of the principal.
- Cycles must be kept locked in the place provided. The school will not be responsible for the safety or security of bicycles.
- No student is permitted to bring a scooter, motorcycle or car to the school.
- **Once admission is done it will not be cancelled at any circumstances.**
- **No money will be refunded.**
- **Only T.C. will be issued for transfer to other school.**

Code of Conduct

- The Management shall have right to introduce measures to improve efficiency and productivity, such as change in workflow, work planning, work systems, procedures, automation, computerization, cutting down unnecessary and avoidable work as the management considers necessary.
- The Management shall at its sole discretion may allot work/duties one department to another, provided his salary and benefits are not adversely affected. If employee is required for the time being, to do work of higher grade than this grade, he may be paid special allowance at the sole discretion of the Management. Parental Co-Operation

- Parents are requested to pay attention to their children's regularity.
- Parents should see the children's diary every day and note the home work and any other instructions given. They should ensure that the sufficient time is set apart for home study.
- All notes given by teachers in the school Almanac must be duly acknowledged by the parent/Guardian.
- Meeting with teachers. If for any reason, guardians wish to meet the Principal / Vice Principal / Headmistress / Class Teacher or Subject Teachers, are welcome to do so. However, appointments must be made prior to all such meetings. Parents are not permitted to the classes or room around in the building as this disturbs the students. The meeting with the concerned person will be at a specified place at a specific time.
- Circulars, invitations etc. sent though the children should be acknowledge on the relevant form in the diary.
- Parents should use the "Leave Record" from in the diary when applying for leave or explaining the absence of their children.
- Parent-Teacher Meeting held on the second Saturday (as per dates given) should be attended regularly. These meeting are held to discuss the performance and progress of their child's development and also help the teachers to give their best towards the overall improvement of the child.

Scholarship

In order to encourage the meritorius students, the NPIS awards monthly & annual scholarship and gold medals.

Fees

Fee schedule will be banded over to parents in the office at the time of admission.

Payment Schedule

Fee is to be paid quarterly / annually / monthly on the **10th** of **every month**. If the guardian fails to pay by the **10th** of month mentioned above they will have to pay a fine of **₹ 100/-** in the month. If they fail to pay in the month the fine goes upto **₹ 500/-**. Failure to pay during this time period will result in your child's name being struck off from the school register.

Extras

The fee structure of the school will be revised from time to time. Expenses on tours, excursions and other exigencies are charged extra as and when required.

The school session commences in April and ends in March, the next yerar.

School Uniform

All students must wear uniform, as appropriate to the day, when attend the school. Students should take pride in their school uniform. Any students arriving at the school, improperly dressed is turned away. Jewellery is not permitted except for a simple earring for girls. Wristwatches are permitted for students in class VI and upward. Uniforms worn to school must be clean and tidy. Incorrect or dirty uniform on 3 occasions will result in the parent being called to the school. If the standard of uniforms does-not improve even after warning parents will be asked to withdraw their children from the school.

Withdrawal

- Before withdrawing a student from the school a month's notice is to given or a month's fee in lieu of notice.
- No school notice leaving certificate will be issued requested in writing by parent and the dues are cleared.
- After taking new admission in any class, if a pupil is absent for 10 days continuously, the name will be struck off the rolls.
- Those who fail in LKG and UKG will not be allowed to continue in the school.
- None of the fee are refundable in case of withdrawal.

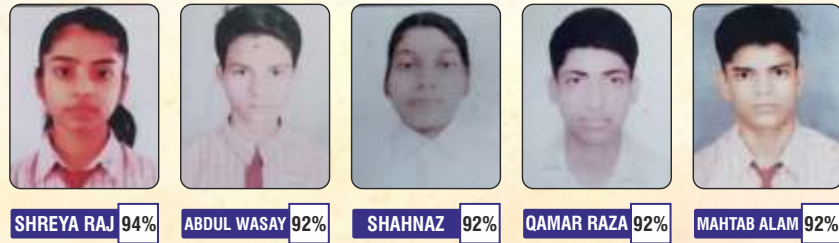

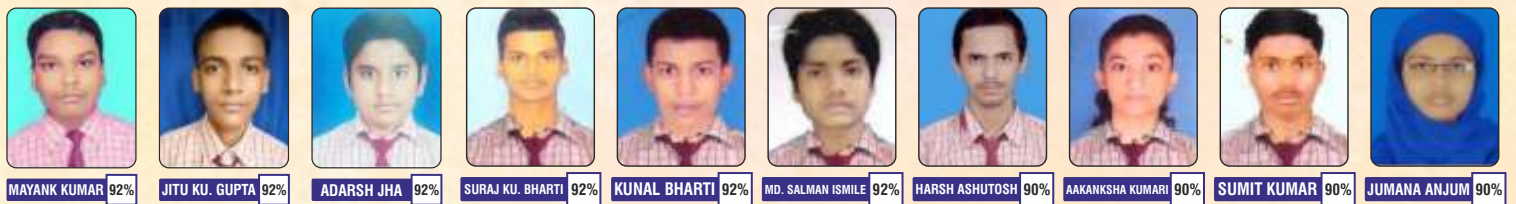
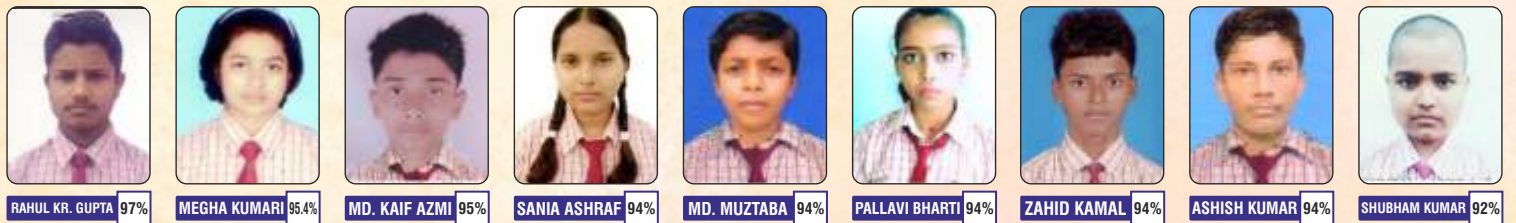


Last Three Years Class X Score Achieve By Students 98%

AMU Qualifier & Class 10th (2021)



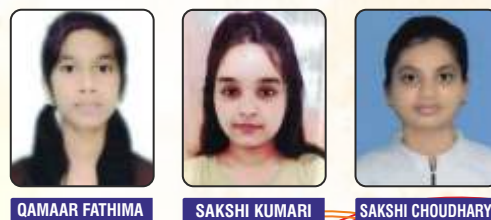
